



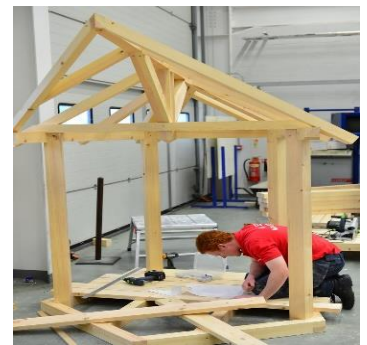
City & Guilds Level 1 Diploma in Carpentry & Joinery (6706)

Who is it suitable for?

For those interested in a career as a trades person working with wood in the construction industry, this qualification is the ideal starting point. You will learn about the industry, including the principles of constructing buildings, and about the types of information used in building design and construction.

What are the aims of the course?

You will learn about health, safety and environmental issues faced on construction sites, and how to communicate with others on the job. You will also learn practical skills specific to wood working, such as maintaining and using carpentry and joinery hand tools, preparing and using carpentry and joinery portable power tools, and producing woodworking joints.



What areas are covered in this course

- Maintain and use carpentry and joinery hand tools
- Prepare and use carpentry and joinery portable power tools
- Produce woodworking joints
- Drawings and diagrams

The assessment will involve end of unit practical and knowledge tests and creation of a portfolio of work.



What will I be able to go on to after I've completed the course?

This qualification helps prepare you for work in the construction industry, with a specific focus on carpentry and joinery. You are likely to progress on to the Level 2 Diploma in Site Carpentry, Bench Joinery or Shopfitting Joinery.
