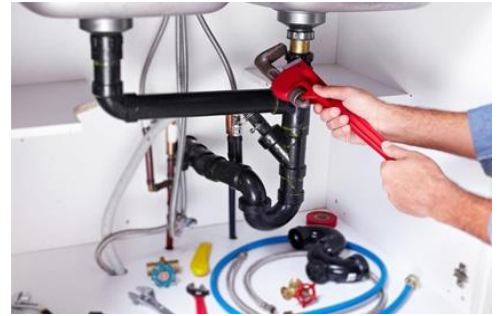


City & Guilds Level 1 in Multi-Skills (6219)

Who is it suitable for?

This is a Level 1 qualification; it will enable you to progress into further learning in the construction sector. You will learn practical skills that enable you to complete common tasks in construction operations.

These qualifications are for candidates wishing to gain some understanding and some practical experience of the variety of trades in the Construction industry.



What are the aims of the course?

This qualification enables you to develop hand-skills in construction operations before progressing to study construction operations in more detail. All of the units develop your practical skills and enable you to demonstrate your ability to complete common tasks within the construction industry.

What areas are covered in this course?

The qualification covers a range of hand-skills and practical tasks in the following trade areas:

- Bricklaying
- Carpentry and Joinery
- Plumbing
- Electrical
- Plastering
- Tiling
- Painting and decorating



The assessment will involve both practical assessments and a portfolio of work.

What will I be able to go on to after I've completed the course?

On completion candidates may wish to progress to trade specialist vocational qualifications at a higher level – for example bricklaying, carpentry, plumbing or electrical.
